## JUDGMENT

1) The respondent's application to strike out for want of jurisdiction is not well-founded and fails.
2) The claimant's claim for unfair dismissal is well-founded and succeeds.
3) The claimant's claim for wrongful dismissal is well-founded and succeeds.
4) The respondent unreasonably failed to comply with the ACAS Code of Practice on disciplinary and grievance procedures and consequently the compensatory award includes an uplift of $15 \%$.
5) Unfair dismissal: the respondent is ordered to pay the claimant (such sums being agreed):
i) $£ 3,264$ by way of basic award;
ii) $£ 21,433.76$ by way of compensatory award (being $£ 18,638.05$ uplifted).
6) Wrongful dismissal: No additional sum is payable in addition to that awarded in respect of the unfair dismissal claim.
