## JUDGMENT

1) The correct name of the respondent is El Shams Cuisine Limited.
2) The respondent has made an unlawful deduction from the claimant's wages and is ordered to pay the claimant the net sum of $£ 216.12$, in respect of the amount unlawfully deducted.
3) The respondent has made an unlawful deduction from the claimant's wages in respect of holiday pay and is ordered to pay the claimant the net sum of $£ 105.99$, in respect of the amount unlawfully deducted.
4) The respondent failed to provide the claimant with a written statement of terms and conditions in accordance with section 1 of the Employment Rights Act 1996. The respondent is therefore ordered to pay the claimant a sum equivalent to four weeks' wages, namely $£ 1,118$. This payment is not subject to deductions for tax and national Insurance.
