# JUDGMENT

1. The claimant's complaint of an unlawful deduction from wages in the sum of  $\pounds$ 2916.67 is well-founded and the tribunal declares accordingly. The respondent is ordered to pay the claimant forthwith the sum of  $\pounds$ 2916.67

2 The claimant's complaint of breach of contract in respect of non-payment expenses is well-founded and the respondent is ordered to pay the claimant forthwith damages in the sum of £55.06p

3. The claimant's complaint of non-payment of holiday pay is well-founded and the tribunal declares accordingly. The respondent is ordered pay the claimant forthwith the sum of £1865.10

4.The claimant's complaint of unlawful deduction from wages (non-payment of commission) is well-founded and the tribunal declares accordingly. The respondent is ordered pay the claimant forthwith the sum of £8320

5. The claimant's complaint of an unlawful deduction from wages (non-payment of car allowance) is not well-founded and is dismissed.
