JUDGMENT

The judgment of the Tribunal is as follows:

- 1. The complaint of unauthorised deductions from pay contrary to Part II Employment Rights Act 1996 in respect of the period 1 August -31 August 2022 is not well-founded and is dismissed.
- 2. The complaint of unauthorised deductions from pay contrary to Part II Employment Rights Act 1996 in respect of the period 1 September -30 September 2022 is not well-founded and is dismissed.
- 3. The complaint of unauthorised deductions from pay contrary to Part II Employment Rights Act 1996 in respect of commission payments for July 2022 relating to properties identified by the parties as number 1 property and number 2 property is not well-founded and is dismissed.
