JUDGMENT

The claimant's claim for unlawful deduction from wages was not submitted within 3 months (plus early conciliation) of the last of a series of alleged deductions in accordance with sections 23(2) and (3) of the Employment Rights Act 1996. It was reasonably practicable for the claim to have been submitted in time and accordingly there is no basis to extend time for the claim under section 23(4). In consequence the tribunal has no jurisdiction to consider this claim.

The claim is dismissed.
