JUDGMENT

The complaint that the claimant was unfairly dismissed and the complaint about failure to pay a statutory redundancy payment are struck out.

REASONS

- 1. The claimant complains of unfair dismissal and failure to pay a statutory redundancy payment.
- 2. Section 108 of the Employment Rights Act 1996 requires a claimant to have not less than two years' service to make an unfair dismissal complaint.
- 3. Section 155 of the Employment Rights Act 1996 requires a claimant to have not less than two years' service to have a right to a redundancy payment.
- 4. The claimant was employed by the respondent for less than two years.
- 5. Therefore, the claimant is not entitled to bring such complaints.
- 6. The claimant has failed to give an acceptable reason, despite being given the opportunity to do so, why the complaints should not be struck out.
- 7. Accordingly, the complaint of unfair dismissal and the complaint of failure to pay a statutory redundancy payment are struck out. The claimant's other complaints are not affected by this judgment.
