## **JUDGMENT**

## **Employment Tribunals Rules of Procedure 2013 – Rule 21**

- The claim was issued in the Midlands East Employment Tribunals on 26 January 2023.
  The respondent has failed to present a valid response on time. The Employment Judge
  has decided that a determination can properly be made of the claim in accordance with
  rule 21 of the Rules of Procedure. The claims against the second, third and fourth
  respondents are dismissed.
- 2. The first respondent has made unauthorised deductions from the claimant's wages and must pay the claimant £5666.66 gross.
- 3. The claimant was dismissed in breach of contract in respect of notice and the respondent must pay damages to the claimant of £2833.33.
- 4. The claimant was dismissed by reason of redundancy and is entitled to a redundancy payment of £1,142.
- 5. The respondent has failed to pay the claimant's holiday entitlement and must pay the claimant £784.62 gross.
- 6. The respondent has failed to pay the Claimant's expenses and must pay the claimant £64.60.
- 7. The respondent has failed to pay the claimant's pension contributions and must pay the claimant £1,133.58.
- 8. The total amount payable by the respondent to the claimant is £11,624.79.
- 9. The hearing listed on 12 July 2023 is cancelled.
