## **JUDGMENT**

- 1. Save for the complaints of disability discrimination and unpaid wages, the Tribunal does not have jurisdiction to determine the other complaints brought by the Claimant against the First Respondent.
- As such, those complaints have no reasonable prospects of success and are struck out pursuant to Rule 37 of Schedule 1 to the Employment Tribunals (Constitution & Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2013.
- 3. The Tribunal does not have jurisdiction to determine any of the complaints brought by the Claimant against the Second Respondent.

4. As such, those complaints have no reasonable prospects of success and are struck out pursuant to Rule 37 of Schedule 1 to the Employment Tribunals (Constitution & Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2013.
