## **JUDGMENT**

**Employment Tribunals Rules of Procedure 2013 - Rule 21** 

- 1. The claim was issued in the East London Employment Tribunals on 21 December 2022. The respondent has failed to present a valid response on time. The Employment Judge has decided that a determination can properly be made of the claim, or part of it, in accordance with rule 21 of the Rules of Procedure.
- 2. The respondent has made unauthorised deductions from the claimant's wages and must pay the claimant £454.71 gross.
- 3. Employment Tribunal cannot award the claimant the income tax refund of £297.20.
- 4. The respondent must pay the claimant £454.71 in total.
- 5. I calculate the amount on a gross basis, but the respondent is entitled to make any deductions which are due for tax and national insurance contributions before payment is made to the claimant.
- 6. The hearing listed on 19 July 2023 is cancelled.
