## JUDGMENT

- 1. The Claimant's claim for breach of contract in respect of expenses payments outstanding at the termination of employment is well-founded.
- 2. The Respondent is ordered to pay the Claimant damages for breach of contract in the sum of £1,354.05.
- 3. The Claimant's claim for breach of contract in respect of commission payments is not well-founded and is dismissed.
- 4. The employer's contract claim brought by the Respondent is not well-founded and is dismissed.
