JUDGMENT

Employment Tribunals Rules of Procedure 2013 – Rule 21

- 1. The claim was issued in the London South Employment Tribunals on 11 December 2023. The respondent has failed to present a valid response on time. The Employment Judge has decided that a determination can properly be made of the claim, or part of it, in accordance with rule 21 of the Rules of Procedure.
- 2. The respondent has made unauthorised deductions from the claimant's wages for the month of August 2023 and 10 days of September 2023, and must pay the claimant £6,666.00 gross.
- 3. The claimant was dismissed in breach of contract in respect of one month's notice pay of £5000.00 gross and the respondent must pay damages to the claimant of £5000.00 gross.
- 4. The respondent has failed to pay the claimant's holiday entitlement of 5 days at £227.00 per day and must pay the claimant £1135.00 gross.
- 5. The respondent must pay the claimant **£12,801.00 gross** in total.
- 6. The claimant must account to HMRC for any sums owed in respect of any payment received pursuant to this judgement.
- 7. The hearing listed on **07 May 2024** is cancelled.
