JUDGMENT

Employment Tribunals Rules of Procedure 2013 - Rule 21

- 1. The claim was issued in the East London Employment Tribunals on 19 February 2024. The respondent has failed to present a valid response on time. The Employment Judge has decided that a determination can properly be made of the claim, or part of it, in accordance with rule 21 of the Rules of Procedure.
- 2. The respondent has made unauthorised deductions from the claimant's wages and must pay the claimant £403.85 gross.
- 3. The claimant was dismissed in breach of contract in respect of notice and the respondent must pay damages to the claimant of £673.07 gross.
- 4. The respondent has failed to pay the claimant's holiday entitlement and must pay the claimant £313.65 gross.
- 5. The respondent did not provide the claimant with a written statement of employment particulars. The claimant has succeeded with claims under Schedule 5 Employment Act 2002. Compensation is awarded equating to two weeks' pay. The respondent must pay the claimant £1,346.14.
- 6. The respondent must pay the claimant £2,736.71 in total.
- 7. The Tribunal does not have jurisdiction to hear the claimant's claim for unfair dismissal because at the time his employment terminated he did not have two years'
