JUDGMENT

1. The Respondent made unlawful deductions from the Claimant's wages, in the sum of £291.41; failed to pay arrears of holiday pay, in the sum of £193.60 and to pay a week's pay in lieu of notice, in the sum of £390.90 and is ordered, therefore, to pay the Claimant the total sum of £875.91.
2. The Claimant's claims of unfair dismissal, for non-payment of a redundancy payment and for 'other payments' are dismissed, on withdrawal.
