## **JUDGMENT**

(Rule 37 Employment Tribunals (Constitution and Rules of Procedure)
Regulations 2013)

- 1. The remaining claims of disability discrimination, unfair dismissal and for unpaid wages are struck out and DISMISSED.
- 2. Those claims are struck out, on the application of the Respondent pursuant to Rule 37(1)(d) of the 2013 Rules because they have not been actively pursued. I am satisfied that there has been an inordinate and inexcusable delay, caused by the Claimant's failure to actively pursue his claims, which gives rise to a substantial risk that a fair final hearing is not now possible.
