## Introduction

The claim has been sent to the registered office of the company above. No response has been presented by the return date or at all, and there is no application for an extension of time. There is sufficient information on the file for me to give Judgment in the claim.

## RULE 21 JUDGMENT

1. The claimant's complaint of unlawful deductions from wages/breach of contract succeeds and the respondent shall pay to him the gross sum of £1950 (one week's unpaid wages and two weeks' notice).
2. The claimant's holiday pay complaint succeeds and the respondent shall pay to him the gross sum of £1040.
3. The claimant's redundancy payment complaint succeeds and the respondent shall pay to him the sum of £3215.
4. The total gross sum payable is **£6205**.
