

## FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000 (SECTION 50)

### DECISION NOTICE

#### **Nature of Complaint**

The Information Commissioner (the "Commissioner") has received a complaint from (the "complainant") which states that on 12<sup>th</sup> February 2005 the following information was requested from Chorley Borough Council under section 1 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (the "Act"):

Confirmation whether the Chorley Borough Council held any evidence to suggest that a particular area of Chorley had a higher incidence of road traffic accidents, compared to other areas of Chorley. Further that if such evidence was held that it be supplied to the complainant

It is alleged that Chorley Borough Council failed to respond to the request within the statutory time period of 20 working days.

#### **The Commissioner's Decision**

Under section 50(1) of the Act, except where a complainant has failed to exhaust a local complaints procedure, or where the complaint is frivolous or vexatious, subject to undue delay, or has been withdrawn, the Commissioner is under a duty to consider whether the request for information has been dealt with in accordance with the requirements of Part I of the Act and to issue a Decision Notice to both the complainant and the public authority.

The Commissioner's decision is as follows:

Chorley Borough Council did not respond to the complainant's request until 6<sup>th</sup> June 2005. The Commissioner's decision in this case is that Chorley Borough Council has not dealt with the complainant's request in accordance with the requirements of Part I of the Act in that it has failed to comply with section 10(1).

Section 10(1) of the Act states:

"..... a public authority must comply with section 1(1) promptly and in any event not later than the twentieth working day following the date of receipt."

Reference: FS50074330

Section 1(1) states :

“Any person making a request for information to a public authority is entitled-

(a) to be informed in writing by the public authority whether it holds information of the description specified in the request, and

(b) if that is the case, to have that information communicated to him.”

### **Action Required**

In view of the fact that Chorley Borough Council responded to the complainant's request on 6<sup>th</sup> June 2005 the Commissioner does not require any further action to be taken.

### **Right of Appeal**

Either party has the right to appeal against this Decision Notice to the Information Tribunal (the “Tribunal”). Information about the appeals process can be obtained from:
