Nature of Complaint

The Information Commissioner (the "Commissioner") has received a complaint which states that on 14th February 2005 the following information was requested from the National Offender Management Service under section 1 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (the "Act"):

Statistical information on :

- i) The number of complaints at HMP Long Lartin between 01/09/04 and 14/02/05
- ii) The number of stage 3 complaints replied, and not replied to by the governing governor at HMP Long Lartin for the same period.

It is alleged that:

The National Offender Management Service did not provide the requested information within 20 working days.

The Commissioner's Decision

Under section 50(1) of the Act, except where a complainant has failed to exhaust a local complaints procedure, or where the complaint is frivolous or vexatious, subject to undue delay, or has been withdrawn, the Commissioner is under a duty to consider whether the request for information has been dealt with in accordance with the requirements of Part I of the Act and to issue a Decision Notice to both the complainant and the public authority.

The Commissioner's decision is as follows:

The National Offender Management Service did not respond to the complainant's request until 8th June 2005 and has therefore breached section 10(1) of the Act. Section 10(1) states:

"Subject to subsections (2) and (3), a public authority must comply with section 1(1) promptly and in any event not later than the twentieth working day following the date of receipt."

Action Required

In view of the fact that National Offender Management Service responded to the complainant's request on 8th June 2005 the Commissioner hereby gives notice that in exercise of his powers under section 50 of the Act he does not require any remedial steps to be taken by the National Offender Management Service.

Right of Appeal

Either party has the right to appeal against this Decision Notice to the Information Tribunal (the "Tribunal"). Information about the appeals process can be obtained from:
