Decision (including any steps ordered)

1. The complainant requested copies of all procedures for handling Freedom of Information requests.

- 2. The Commissioner's decision is that the public authority did not deal with the request in accordance with the FOIA. This is because the public authority provided its response outside the statutory 20 working days and it has therefore breached section 10(1) of the FOIA.
- 3. As the requested information was provided during the course of the investigation, the Commissioner does not require any steps to be taken.

Request and response

4. On 12 April 2013, the complainant requested information in the following terms:

'Please provide copies of all internal policies, procedures, protocols and guidance for staff on handling Freedom of Information Act and Environmental Information Regulations requests. This should include any documents relating to the receipt, handling and processing of requests, documents relating to the consideration of whether information is exempt from disclosure, and documents relating to dealing with requests for internal reviews.'

Scope of the case

5. On 7 July 2013, the complainant contacted the Commissioner to complain about the lack of a response. On 17 July 2013 the complainant stated that NHS had disclosed this information to him.

Reasons for decision

6. Section 10 of the FOIA provides that a public authority should respond to a request for information within 20 working days. The Commissioner has found a breach in this case because the public authority did not respond within 20 working days.
