Decision (including any steps ordered)

- 1. The complainant has requested information in relation to a previous information request he made dated 24 April 2014 and subsequent complaints and investigations flowing from that request. Camden & Islington NHS Foundation Trust responded to the complainant but it did not do so within the statutory time for compliance.
- 2. The Commissioner's decision is that Trust has breached section 10 in the handling of this request.
- 3. The Commissioner requires no steps to be taken.

Request and response

4. On 18 December 2014, the complainant made a request to the Trust for the following information:

"Under provisions in the Freedom of Information Act 2000 please provide me copies of all information (internal and external emails, notes, letters, memos, etc.) you hold in relation to my information request dated 24 April 2014 and subsequent complaints and investigations flowing from that request.

Rather confusingly, the Trust has allocated several different case numbers to this matter including 2014-121, 2014-022, 2014-045. The Information Commissioners Office case reference is FS50554763."

5. The Trust responded to the complainant on 20 March 2015.

Scope of the case

- 6. The complainant contacted the Commissioner on 13 February 2015 to make a complaint as the Trust had not responded to his request.
- 7. During the course of the Commissioner's investigation the Trust did respond to the complainant. The Commissioner has considered whether the Trust has complied with section 10 FOIA in its handling of this request.

Reasons for decision

- 8. Section 10 of FOIA states that, "Subject to subsections (2) and (3), a public authority must comply with section 1(1) promptly and in any event not later than the twentieth working day following the date of receipt."
- 9. In this case the complainant submitted his request on 18 December 2014 and the Trust did not respond until 20 March 2015. The Trust did not therefore respond within 20 working days. As it did not respond within the statutory time for compliance it breached section 10(1) FOIA in relation to its handling of this request.
