# Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) Decision notice

## **Decision (including any steps ordered)**

- 1. The complainant requested information from NHS Nene Clinical Commissioning Group ("the CCG") about names and job/role title of all the CCG staff.
- 2. The Commissioner's decision is that the CCG failed to respond to the request within 20 working days and therefore breached Section 10 of the Freedom of Information Act ("the FOIA").
- 3. As a response has been issued, the Commissioner does not require the CCG to take any further steps.

#### **Request and response**

4. On 14 November 2018, the complainant wrote to the CCG and requested information in the following terms:

"To whom it may concern,

Under FOIA - May I have the name and job / role title (only) of all Nene Commissioning staff.

Please supply as a pdf or excel if easier."

5. The CCG provided a response on 14 December 2018.

### Scope of the case

6. The complainant contacted the Commissioner on 16 December 2018 to complain about the way his request for information had been handled and he specifically requested a decision notice recording the late response provided by the CCG.

#### Reasons for decision

7. Section 1(1) of the FOIA states that:

> Any person making a request for information to a public authority is entitled -

- (a) to be informed in writing by the public authority whether it holds information of the description specified in the request, and
- (b) if that is the case, to have that information communicated to him.
- 8. Section 10(1) of the FOIA states that a public authority must respond to a request promptly and "not later than the twentieth working day following the date of receipt."
- 9. From the evidence provided to the Commissioner in this case, it is clear that in failing to issue a response to the request within 20 working days, the CCG has breached Section 10(1) of the FOIA.
