

Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) Decision notice

Decision (including any steps ordered)

- The complainant has requested information regarding Education, Health and Care Plans (EHCP) and Special Educational Needs and Disability (SEND) information. This request also included tribunal information, costs and meeting reports.
- 2. The Commissioner's decision is that Suffolk County Council (the Council) was entitled to aggregate the request under section 12(4) of FOIA and to refuse to comply with the request in accordance of section 12(1) of FOIA.
- 3. The Commissioner does not require the Council to take any further action.

Request and response

- 4. On 19 July 2022, the complainant wrote to the Council and requested information regarding Education, Health and Care Plans (EHCP) and Special Educational Needs and Disability (SEND) information. This request also included tribunal information, costs and meeting reports. The full requests can be found in the annex below, highlighted in bold.
- 5. The Council responded on 15 August 2022. It stated that it does hold the information requested, but refused the request under section 12 of the FOIA. The Council upheld this decision in its internal review.



Reasons for decision

- 6. Section 1(1) does not oblige a public authority to comply with a request for information if the authority estimates that the cost of complying with the request would exceed the appropriate limit.
- Section 12 allows a public authority to refuse to comply with a request for information if the authority estimates that the cost of compliance would exceed the 'appropriate limit', as defined by the Freedom of Information and Data Protection (Appropriate Limit and Fees) Regulations 2004 ("the Regulations").
- 8. In Decision Notice IC-181080-P4X1¹ the Commissioner found that the Public Authority was entitled to rely on section 12 due to the cost of complying with the request.
- 9. When estimating whether the appropriate limit is likely to be exceeded, it can include the costs of complying with two or more requests if the conditions laid out in regulation 5 of the Fees Regulations can be satisfied. Those conditions require the requests to be:
 - made by one person, or by different persons who appear to the public authority to be acting in concert or in pursuance of a campaign;
 - made for the same or similar information; and
 - received by the public authority within any period of 60 consecutive working days.
- 10. The Commissioner is satisfied that regulation 5 of the fees regulation is satisfied as all three conditions have been met and complying with the 6 requests would exceed the cost limit.
- 11. The Council went on to break down each request submitted by the Complainant and explained that a Public Authority can refuse requests for information where the cost of dealing with them would exceed the appropriate cost limit. In this instance the appropriate limit for the Council is set at £450/18 hours of work².

12. We are also satisfied that the Council has met its obligations under Section 16 by advising that if you are able to submit no more than 2 FOI requests a month, it's likely that it may be able to provide you with the information.



Right of appeal
