Decision (including any steps ordered)

- 1. The complainant has requested minutes of a cross-government group.
- 2. The Commissioner's decision is that the above public authority is entitled to rely on section 23 of FOIA and does not need to take further steps.

Request and response

- 3. On 6 September 2022, the complainant wrote to the above public authority and requested copies of minutes of the National Security Liaison Group.
- 4. The above public authority responded on 5 October 2022. Its final position was to rely on section 23 of FOIA to withhold the information.

Reasons for decision

- The Commissioner recognises the complainant's interest in transparency. However, the broad reach of this exemption has been confirmed by FOIA caselaw.
- 6. For the same reasoning given in decision notice <u>IC-211046-V6R1</u>, the Commissioner is satisfied that section 23 of FOIA applies here.
