- The cost of Goldsmiths' initial purchase of the SEAtS software, app, and other hardware or software necessary to its function
- Costs incurred during its implementation, such as training staff and configuring the system
- The annual cost of its subscription and upkeep as per Goldsmiths' contract with SEAtS
- The Terms and Conditions in Goldsmiths' contract with SEAtS which relates to what data can be collected, used, and passed on to thirdparties and why

Please confirm receipt of this request. If you decide to withhold information please provide guidance on how I can adjust my request to make it successful."

Commissioner's Decision:

The public authority must take this step within 30 calendar days of the date of this decision notice. Failure to comply may result in the Commissioner making written certification of this fact to the High Court pursuant to section 54 of FOIA and may be dealt with as a contempt of court.

Right of Appeal:
