DECISION

1. On 14 August 2000 I issued a decision in respect of this application under section 28 by

Mr Francis Vause. In accordance with paragraph 16.3 of Practice Direction Part 49E made under the

Civil Procedure Rules 1998, any appeal from my decision had to be lodged within six weeks, that is

by 25 September 2000. However, under paragraph 16.5 of Practice Direction Part 49E I have the

power to extend the appeal period if a request is made prior to the expiry of the six week period.

2. On 22 September 2000, that is before the period had expired, Wilson Gunn M'Caw, the agent

acting for Mr Vause, requested an extension of one month. In a letter containing this request, the agent

explained that Mr Vause is seeking legal aid and awaits a decision from the Legal Aid Board.

3. I recognise that Mr Vause may not wish to commit himself to the costs associated with the

preparation of an appeal before he knows the outcome of his application for legal aid, and I consider

that it is reasonable to extend the appeal period in this case. Accordingly, I allow a further month from

25 September for a Notice of Appeal to be lodged. The period will now expire on 25 October 2000.
