SUPPLEMENTARY DECISION

10 My written decision in these proceedings, dated 16 October 2000, contained a clerical error. It
has been brought to my attention that on line 9 of page 1 of the decision application No
2024326 is referred to as being for the mark “Meat Loaf”. That is not correct. Application No
2024326 should have been described as being for the mark “Bat out of Hell”. The necessary
power to correct this error is provided by Rule 40.12(1) of the Civil Procedure Rules which
states:

“The Court may at any time correct an accidental slip or omission in a judgement or
order”.

20 I therefore correct my written decision in these proceedings by amending “Meat Loaf” to “Bat
out of Hell” on the ninth line of page 1.
