DECISION

1 Following the international phase of international patent application number

PCT/US98/03413, patent application number GB 9920058.6 entered the national phase

in the UK and was subsequently published as GB 2338736 and proceeded to grant The

original PCT application named two inventors, Peter A Quigley and Stephen C Nolet.

2 Jerry G Williams has now made an application in accordance with Section 13(1) of the Act

to the effect that he ought also to have been mentioned as a joint inventor.

3 The named inventors and the patent proprietors, Fiberspar Corporation, have confirmed

in writing that they consent to Jerry G Williams being named as an additional joint

inventor. I therefore conclude that the relevant parties agree that Jerry G Williams was a

joint inventor.

Accordingly I find that Jerry G Williams should be mentioned as a joint inventor in the

granted patent for the invention. I also direct in accordance with Rule 14(5) that an

addendum slip mentioning him as a joint inventor should be prepared for the granted

patent.
