ISSUE

Whether application number SPC/GB/03/036 complies with Article 8

HEARING OFFICER

DECISION

- The examiner wrote to Peptech Limited ("the applicant") on 24 December 2003 and again on 12 February 2004 stating that its application no. SPC/GB/03/036 for a supplementary protection certificate ("the application") did not comply with the requirements of Article 8 of Council Regulation (EEC) No. 1768/92 ("the Regulation"). The applicant did not respond to the examiner's objections within the period specified for reply and in an official letter dated 3 August 2004 the examiner gave the applicant a further opportunity to respond to the objections raised in the earlier letters. This further letter also stated that if no response was received by 2 September 2004, a Hearing Officer acting for the Comptroller would decide whether the application should be rejected under Article 10(2) of the Regulation.
- The applicant has not responded within the specified period and has not asked to be heard. In the absence of any response from the applicant I am satisfied that the application does not satisfy the requirements of Article 8 and I reject it under Article 10(2).

Appeal
