DECISION AND GROUNDS OF DECISION

Background

On 12 February 2004, Lynnet Leisure Properties Ltd, 40 Fox Street, Glasgow G2 4AY,

United Kingdom applied under the Trade Marks Act 1994 to register the trade mark 'THE

OLD FIRM' in Class 43 for the following specification of goods:

'Services for providing food and drink; temporary accommodation.'

Case for Registration

The application was examined under the provisions of Section 37(1) of the Act and the

applicant informed that the requirements were not met because objections arose under

Sections 5(2) of the Act. The examination report was issued on 10 March 2004.

Decision

A period of 6 months was allowed for the applicant to respond under Section 37(3) of the

Act. However, by the 13 October 2004 no response had been received and the application

was therefore refused in accordance with Section 37(4) of the Act.
