DECISION

- 1 Patents Form 7/77 names one inventor, Yan Cheong Chan.
- 2 Tan Chee Wei has now made an application in accordance with section 13(1) of the Act to the effect that he ought also to have been mentioned as a joint inventor.
- Yan Cheong Chan and the patent applicant, City University of Hong Kong, have confirmed in writing that they consent to the application. I therefore conclude that all relevant parties agree that Tan Chee Wei should also be named as a joint inventor.
- Accordingly I find that Tan Chee Wei should be mentioned as a joint inventor in any patent granted for the invention. I also direct, in accordance with rule 14(5), that an addendum slip mentioning him as a joint inventor be prepared for the published patent application for the invention.
