Li as the sole inventor on patent number

DECISION

- 1 Patents Form 7/77 names one inventor: Jian-Qun Li.
- Wonderland Nurserygoods Company Limited, the patent proprietor, has filed an application in accordance with rule 10(2) of the Patents Rules 2007 to the effect that Guang-Hui Zhao should be named as the sole inventor. They have also filed an application under section 13(3) of the Patents Act 1977 to remove Jian-Qun Li as the named inventor on this patent.
- Jian-Qun Li has filed written consent in support of this application. For his part, Guang-Hui Zhao has also confirmed in writing he should be named as the sole inventor. I therefore conclude that all relevant parties agree that Jian-Qun Li should not be mentioned as the sole inventor in relation to patent number GB 2488225 and that he should be replaced by Guang-Hui Zhao.
- Accordingly I find that Guang-Hui Zhao should be mentioned as the sole inventor of the patent and I direct, in accordance with rule 10(1), that an addendum slip mentioning him as the sole inventor be prepared for the published patent application and granted patent for the invention.

This decision also serves as a certificate, issued in accordance with section 13(3), to the effect that Jian-Qun Li should not have been mentioned as the sole inventor in both the published patent application and granted patent for the invention.
