BACKGROUND AND PLEADINGS

1) On 4 January 2017, Mezrin Lurii Valeriiovych ("the holder") applied to protect, in the UK, International Trade Mark registration number 1354634 for the following mark:

content guru

2) The International Registration ("IR") claims a priority date of 3 November 2016 based upon an earlier Ukraine national mark. It was accepted and published in the Trade Marks Journal on 6 October 2017. On 11 January 2018, the holder added the voluntarily disclaimer "No claim is made to the exclusive right to use 'GURU' apart from the mark as shown" and limited its list of services to the following:

Class 35: Web indexing for commercial or advertising purposes; market studies; opinion polling; providing business information via a web site; compilation of information into computer databases; compilation of statistics: commercial information and advice for consumers [consumer advice shop]; marketing; marketing research; provision of an on-line marketplace for buyers and sellers of goods and services; writing of publicity texts; scriptwriting for advertising purposes; word processing; updating of advertising material; updating and maintenance of data in computer databases; web site traffic optimization / web site traffic optimisation; rental of advertising space; commercial information agency services; outsourcing services [business assistance]; commercial intermediation services; layout services for advertising purposes; news clipping services; advertising agency services / publicity agency services; search engine optimization for sales promotion/search engine optimisation for sales promotion; presentation of goods of communication media, for retail purposes; publicity material rental; rental of advertising time on communication media; direct mail advertising; publication of publicity texts; advertising / publicity; pay per click advertising; advertising by mail order; on-line advertising on a computer network; dissemination of advertising matter; design of advertising materials; systemization of information into computer databases; sales promotion for others; production of advertising films; negotiation and conclusion of commercial transactions for third parties.

Class 41: Videotaping; electronic desktop publishing; providing on-line videos, not downloadable; providing on-line electronic publications, not downloadable; providing on-line

music, not downloadable; game services provided on-line from a computer network; writing of texts; layout services, other than for advertising purposes; providing amusement arcade services; club services [entertainment or education]; translation; mobile library services / bookmobile services; news reporters services; recording studio services; photographic reporting; music composition services; on-line publication of electronic books and journals; publication of books; publication of texts, other than publicity texts; entertainment services; production of music; film production, other than advertising films.

Class 42: Web site design consultancy; software as a service [SaaS]; creating and maintaining web sites for others.

- 3) O2 Worldwide Limited ("the opponent") opposes the IR. The opposition is directed against all the services. The opponent relies upon one earlier UK trade mark and five earlier European Union (formerly Community) trade marks. Full details of these are provided in an annex to this decision. Whilst the opponent has not withdrawn its reliance upon any of these earlier marks, it subsequently identified reliance upon two of these marks as being the closer marks with the opponent highlighting certain services. The first of these, is its EU registration 16057011 ("the '011 mark") in respect of the mark O2 GURU. Upon examination of the relevant dates, the priority date of the contested IR is 3 November 2016 and the filing date of the '011 mark is 18 November 2016. The significance of these two dates is that because the filing date of the 011 mark is later than the priority date of the contested IR it does not qualify as an earlier mark under section 6(1)(a) of the Act. Consequently, the opponent is not able to rely upon this registration.
- 4) The second mark identified as being a "closer mark" is its UK registration 3024436 for the series of two marks GURU/Guru ("the '436 mark"). The relevant details of this mark are shown below:

- 5) This mark qualifies as an "earlier mark" under section 6(1)(a) of the Act, by virtue of the fact that its filing date predate the priority date of the contested designation. With the exception of the opponent's '011 mark, the other registrations also qualify as "earlier marks". I will keep these other earlier marks in mind for my considerations.
- 6) The opponent's grounds are as follows:
 - Registration of the contested IR would be contrary to section 5(2)(b) of the
 Trade Marks Act 1994 ("the Act") because the contested sign is similar to the
 earlier marks, that the contested services are identical or very similar to the

- services of the opponent's earlier marks and that there is a likelihood of confusion:
- Use of the contested IR would offend under section 5(3) of the Act because it is similar to the opponent's earlier marks that have a "a massive reputation [...] throughout the European Union" in respect of the opponent's "core telecommunication goods and services, and its entertainment, repair/support, research and training services". Use of the contested IR, without due cause, would take unfair advantage of, or be detrimental to the distinctive character or repute of the opponent's earlier marks, in particular the opponent's marks "portray a young, trendy, cool, and high tech brand to its consumers" and as a consequence "the fact that the Applicant [holder] has adopted the Opponent's trade mark in its Application":
 - (i) will take unfair advantage and/or repute of [its] mark. It asserts that the holder's IR will bring the opponent's mark to mind and consequently it will take unfair advantage;
 - (ii) Upon seeing the holder's IR, the consumer may also believe that it is the opponent's mark or that there is an economic connection between the parties, therefore, giving the holder an unfair advantage;
 - (iii) If its use is in respect of a poor type or quality of service, this could result in detriment to the distinctive character or repute of the opponent's marks. As a result, the repute of the earlier marks would be tarnished and harmed:
 - (iv) The distinctiveness of the earlier marks is such that any use of the holder's mark would result in diluting its distinctiveness resulting in a change of consumers' economic behaviour.
- 7) The holder filed a counterstatement denying the claims made.
- 8) Only the opponent filed evidence, but the holder did file observations in reply. I will refer to the evidence to the extent that I consider it necessary and I will keep the holder's observations in mind. A hearing took place before me on 1 November 2018 where the opponent was represented by Julius Stobbs for Stobbs. The holder did not attend nor was it represented at the hearing.

9) The holder was represented in these proceedings by DLA Piper UK LLP.

Opponent's Evidence

10) This takes the form of a witness statement by Peter Holmes, Director of Brand of one of the subsidiary companies which form part of "The Telefonica Group of Companies" (hereafter, "his companies") which includes the opponent. Mr Holmes provides evidence with the aim of establishing his companies' reputation in their GURU trade mark in the UK prior to the relevant date, being the priority date claimed for the contested IR, namely 3 November 2016. I will refer to this evidence, as necessary, in my decision.

DECISION

Section 5(2)(b)

- 11) Section 5(2)(b) of the Act is as follows:
 - "5(2) A trade mark shall not be registered if because-
 - (b) it is similar to an earlier trade mark and is to be registered for goods or services identical with or similar to those for which the earlier trade mark is protected, there exists a likelihood of confusion on the part of the public, which includes the likelihood of association with the earlier trade mark".

Comparison of goods and services

12) In the judgment of the Court of Justice of the European Union ("the CJEU") in *Canon*, Case C-39/97, the court stated at paragraph 23 of its judgment that:

"In assessing the similarity of the goods or services concerned, as the French and United Kingdom Governments and the Commission have pointed out, all the relevant factors relating to those goods or services themselves should be taken into account. Those factors include, inter alia, their nature, their intended purpose and their method of use and whether they are in competition with each other or are complementary".

- 13) The relevant factors identified by Jacob J. (as he then was) in the *Treat* case, [1996] R.P.C. 281, for assessing similarity were:
 - a) The respective users of the respective goods or services;
 - b) The physical nature of the goods or acts of services;
 - c) The respective trade channels through which the goods or services reach the market:
 - d) In the case of self-serve consumer items, where in practice they are respectively found or likely to be found in supermarkets and in particular whether they are, or are likely to be, found on the same or different shelves:
 - e) The extent to which the respective goods or services are competitive. This inquiry may take into account how those in trade classify goods, for instance whether market research companies, who of course act for industry, put the goods or services in the same or different sectors.
- 14) In relation to the assessment of the respective specifications, I note that in *YouView TV Ltd v Total Ltd* [2012] EWHC 3158 (Ch), Floyd J. (as he then was) stated that:
 - "... Trade mark registrations should not be allowed such a liberal interpretation that their limits become fuzzy and imprecise: see the observations of the CJEU in Case C-307/10 *The Chartered Institute of Patent Attorneys (Trademarks) (IP TRANSLATOR)* [2012] ETMR 42 at [47]-[49]. Nevertheless the principle should not be taken too far. Treat was decided the

way it was because the ordinary and natural, or core, meaning of 'dessert sauce' did not include jam, or because the ordinary and natural description of jam was not 'a dessert sauce'. Each involved a straining of the relevant language, which is incorrect. Where words or phrases in their ordinary and natural meaning are apt to cover the category of goods in question, there is equally no justification for straining the language unnaturally so as to produce a narrow meaning which does not cover the goods in question."

- 15) I also keep in mind the following guidance of the General Court in *Gérard Meric v*Office for Harmonisation in the Internal Market, Case T- 133/05 ("Meric"):
 - "29. In addition, the goods can be considered as identical when the goods designated by the earlier mark are included in a more general category, designated by trade mark application (Case T-388/00 Institut fur Lernsysteme v OHIM- Educational Services (ELS) [2002] ECR II-4301, paragraph 53) or where the goods designated by the trade mark application are included in a more general category designated by the earlier mark".
- 16) At the hearing, Mr Stobbs made a number of submissions that I summarise, and comment upon below:

Class 35

Web indexing for commercial or advertising purposes; opinion polling; marketing; marketing research; writing of publicity texts; scriptwriting for advertising purposes; updating of advertising material; web site traffic optimization / web site traffic optimisation; rental of advertising space; layout services for advertising purposes; news clipping services; advertising agency services / publicity agency services; search engine optimization for sales promotion/search engine optimisation for sales promotion; publicity material rental; rental of advertising time on communication media; direct mail advertising; publication of publicity texts; advertising / publicity; pay per click advertising; advertising by mail order; on-line advertising on a computer network; dissemination of advertising matter; design of advertising materials

- 17) It is submitted that the opponent's Retail services and online retail services connected with [...] computer application software, computer software, computer software downloadable from the Internet, [...], printed matter, books, magazines, [...] and many other goods, and also information and advisory services relating to the aforesaid services; information and advisory services relating to the aforesaid services provided on-line from a computer database or the Internet; information and advisory services relating to the aforesaid services provided over a telecommunications network covers the applicant's services or are, at least, highly similar.
- 18) I disagree. Bearing in mind the *Youview* guidance set out above regarding not unnaturally straining the language of the specification, I find that retail services on the one hand and the various types of the applicant's advertising services on the other are not identical. The provider of retail services and the provider of advertising services are not the same and neither are the consumers with advertising services normally being offered to commercial enterprises and retail services being offered to the general public. There is some overlap of nature and intended purpose in that retail services involve an element of advertising of the goods for sale and advertising services includes such services with the purpose of promoting third party goods. That said, it is not normal for the respective services to be in competition. In summary, I find that the level of similarity is no more than low.

Market studies; providing business information via a web site; compilation of statistics: commercial information and advice for consumers [consumer advice shop]; provision of an on-line marketplace for buyers and sellers of goods and services; presentation of goods of communication media, for retail purposes; sales promotion for others; production of advertising films

19) It is submitted that the opponent's Retail services and online retail services connected with [...] computer application software, computer software, computer software downloadable from the Internet, [...], printed matter, books, magazines, [...] and many other goods., and also information and advisory services relating to the aforesaid services; information and advisory services relating to the aforesaid services provided on-line from a computer database or the Internet; information and

advisory services relating to the aforesaid services provided over a telecommunications network are identical to the holder's services.

- 20) I agree that the underlined services are at least highly similar if not identical to the holder's retail services. Further, the remainder of the holder's services are covered by, or overlap with the opponent's information and advisory services and are, therefore, identical.
- 21) In respect of the holder's other Class 35 services, namely, compilation of information into computer databases, [...] word processing; updating and maintenance of data in computer databases; outsourcing services [business assistance]; commercial intermediation services; systemization of information into computer databases and commercial information agency services; negotiation and conclusion of commercial transactions for third parties, it is not obvious to me that these share any similarity to any of the goods and services covered by the '436 mark. However, I note that they are identical to equivalent terms in the opponent's earlier EU mark 13092887 "O2Guru" and cloud device ("the '887 mark").

Class 41

22) Mr Stobbs submitted that the following services are self-evidently identical or at least very similar and he suggested that no further analysis is required:

Holder's services

publishing services); non-downloadable electronic publications; arranging and conducting of courses, seminars and workshops; [...]; production, presentation and distribution of audio, video, still and moving images and data provided online from a computer database or the Internet; information and advisory services relating to the aforesaid; information and advisory services relating to the aforesaid services provided on-line from a computer database or the Internet; information and advisory services relating to the aforesaid services provided over a telecommunications network.

<u>entertainment services</u>; <u>production of music</u>; <u>film production</u>, <u>other than advertising films</u>.

- 23) I agree that the underlined terms are identical or obviously covered by various terms in the opponent's specification such as *entertainment* and the various *publishing* services.
- 24) In respect of the remaining services, I comment as follows:
 - writing of texts: such services are closely related to the provision of information and advisory services and also publishing services and are similar to a reasonable extent;
 - layout services, other than for advertising purposes: these form part of a suite
 of services covered by the opponent's broad term Publication of texts, other
 than publicity texts and its other publication services and is, therefore,
 identical:
 - club services [... education]; translation mobile library services / bookmobile services; news reporters services; photographic reporting: none of these services have an equivalent term in the opponent's specification and they are not obviously an "entertainment service" and are, consequently, not covered by such a broad term. In the absence of submissions on why they are identical or similar, I find that they are not similar to the opponent's services.
 - recording studio services; music composition services: these are similar to the
 opponent's production ...of audio data and Production of music because they
 are all services that form part of the process of producing recorded music and

are complementary to each other and will be accessed via the same trade channels. I find that there is a medium to high level of similarity.

Class 42

25) Mr Stobbs, once again, submitted that the following lists of services are "almost entirely identical or at least very similar" and that no further analysis is required:

- 26) I agree that *Web site design consultancy* is covered by the opponent's *creating* and maintaining websites for others and is, therefore, identical.
- 27) I understand the term *software as a service [SaaS]* to be a reference to software applications that are hosted by a service provider to make services available via these applications. This has parallels with creating and hosting websites for others with both services being similar ways to deliver services over the Internet. With this in mind, I find that the respective services share a medium to high level of similarity.
- 28) *creating and maintaining web sites for others* is present in both specifications and is, self-evidently identical.

Comparison of marks

- 29) It is clear from *Sabel BV v. Puma AG* (particularly paragraph 23), Case C-251/95, that the average consumer normally perceives a mark as a whole and does not proceed to analyse its various details. The same case also explains that the visual, aural and conceptual similarities of the marks must be assessed by reference to the overall impressions created by the marks, bearing in mind their distinctive and dominant components. The CJEU stated at paragraph 34 of its judgment in Case C-591/12P, *Bimbo SA v OHIM*, that:
 - ".....it is necessary to ascertain, in each individual case, the overall impression made on the target public by the sign for which registration is sought, by means of, inter alia, an analysis of the components of a sign and of their relative weight in the perception of the target public, and then, in the light of that overall impression and all factors relevant to the circumstances of the case, to assess the likelihood of confusion."
- 30) It would be wrong, therefore, to artificially dissect the trade marks, although, it is necessary to take into account the distinctive and dominant components of the marks and to give due weight to any other features which are not negligible and therefore contribute to the overall impressions created by the marks.
- 31) As I mentioned earlier, at the hearing, Mr Stobbs identified the opponent's earlier marks UK 3024436 GURU/Guru (series of 2) and EU 16057011 O2 GURU as being clearly "the closer marks". However, the latter mark is not an earlier mark under section 6(1)(a) of the Act. I will base my considerations on the '436 mark. I will refer to the other earlier marks relied upon, as necessary, later in my decision. The difference in presentation of the two marks in the series of the '436 mark has no impact upon the outcome of the proceedings because both forms are in ordinary typeface and notional and fair use of each will include use in the form of the other.
- 32) The respective marks are:

- 33) The earlier mark consists of the word GURU and this is self-evidently the dominant and distinctive element. The IR is a mark that consists of the two words "content guru" presented in an unremarkable typeface. The words form a unit with both words sharing equal dominance in the mark with the first word qualifying the second word.
- 34) Visually and aurally, the marks share similarity because of the presence of GURU in both marks which will be pronounced as the syllables GOO-ROO. There is a difference created by the word CONTENT appearing at the start of the contested mark, consisting of the two syllables CONT-ENT or CON-TENT. Taking all of this into account, I conclude that the respective marks share a medium level of visual and aural similarity.
- 35) At the hearing, Mr Stobbs submitted that the word GURU will be understood as describing a "spiritual leader". I also note the following definition:

"An influential teacher or popular expert.

'a management guru'"1

36) Mr Stobbs pointed out the example given in this reference, namely, "management guru" and suggested that this did not show descriptive use in respect of the goods and services at issue in the case. I dismiss this submission. The dictionary provides an example, and I do not consider it to be the only context in which the word "Guru" could be used to indicate an influential teacher or popular expert. With this in mind, it is my firm view that the holder's mark will be understood as strongly alluding to an expert in the field of "content". In this respect, I accept Mr

Stobbs' submission that "content" will be understood as a reference to information on a website and such a meaning is supported by the following definitions:

"Information made available by a website or other electronic medium.

[as modifier] 'online content providers'"2

37) The opponent's mark has a less clear meaning because the word GURU is not qualified in any way and, consequently, upon encountering the mark, the impression created may be either that of a spiritual leader or a popular expert. Taking all of this into account, there is a low or no level of conceptual similarity where the opponent's mark is perceived as meaning "spiritual leader", but slightly higher where it is perceived as meaning a "teacher" or "expert".

Average consumer and the purchasing act

38) The average consumer is deemed to be reasonably well informed and reasonably observant and circumspect. For the purpose of assessing the likelihood of confusion, it must be borne in mind that the average consumer's level of attention is likely to vary according to the category of goods or services in question: *Lloyd Schuhfabrik Meyer, Case C-342/97*.

39) In Hearst Holdings Inc, Fleischer Studios Inc v A.V.E.L.A. Inc, Poeticgem Limited, The Partnership (Trading) Limited, U Wear Limited, J Fox Limited, [2014] EWHC 439 (Ch), Birss J. described the average consumer in these terms:

"60. The trade mark questions have to be approached from the point of view of the presumed expectations of the average consumer who is reasonably well informed and reasonably circumspect. The parties were agreed that the relevant person is a legal construct and that the test is to be applied objectively by the court from the point of view of that constructed person. The

words "average" denotes that the person is typical. The term "average" does not denote some form of numerical mean, mode or median."

40) The respective services cover a broad range from retail services, where the consumer is the ordinary member of the public and where the purchasing process may be casual and impulsive, to specialist services such as opinion polling that is only likely to be undertaken for commercial clients, whose purchasing process will be well considered with attention being paid to the method by which such services will be carried out. In all cases though, the purchasing process is likely to be primarily visual in nature with service providers being identified from perusal of the high street, the Internet or other online guides. However, I keep in mind that aural factors may be relevant where services are accessed by telephone or where such services are promoted via aural methods such as radio advertising.

Distinctive character of the earlier trade marks

- 41) In Lloyd Schuhfabrik Meyer & Co. GmbH v Klijsen Handel BV, Case C-342/97 the CJEU stated that:
 - "22. In determining the distinctive character of a mark and, accordingly, in assessing whether it is highly distinctive, the national court must make an overall assessment of the greater or lesser capacity of the mark to identify the goods or services for which it has been registered as coming from a particular undertaking, and thus to distinguish those goods or services from those of other undertakings (see, to that effect, judgment of 4 May 1999 in Joined Cases C-108/97 and C-109/97 WindsurfingChiemsee v Huber and Attenberger [1999] ECR I-0000, paragraph 49).
 - 23. In making that assessment, account should be taken, in particular, of the inherent characteristics of the mark, including the fact that it does or does not contain an element descriptive of the goods or services for which it has been registered; the market share held by the mark; how intensive, geographically widespread and long-standing use of the mark has been; the amount invested by the undertaking in promoting the mark; the proportion of the relevant

section of the public which, because of the mark, identifies the goods or services as originating from a particular undertaking; and statements from chambers of commerce and industry or other trade and professional associations (see *Windsurfing Chiemsee*, paragraph 51)."

- 42) I have identified that the opponent's GURU mark is likely to be perceived as having one of two meanings, namely, "a spiritual leader" or "a popular expert". Where the mark is perceived as a reference to the former, the level of inherent distinctive character will be close to average. Where the latter meaning is perceived it will have a very low level of distinctive character.
- 43) Mr Holmes' evidence is intended to illustrate the opponent's reputation in its various GURU marks at the relevant date. This evidence can be summarised as follows:
 - The opponent is one of the major mobile telecommunications providers in the UK with nearly 25 million UK customers in December 2014³;
 - The opponent's GURU support service has been in place since 2009 that is its name for its in-store technical experts offering free, impartial advice⁴;
 - In 2010 the opponent employed 250 Gurus in its O2 branded stores and this had increased to 350 by 2011⁵;
 - In 2011, the service was expanded with the launch of O2 Guru TV, a new YouTube channel offering free support and advice. In 2014, the Guru TV service was extended to business customers⁶;
 - An article that appeared on the website www.campaignlive.co.uk, dated 7
 October 2014, reported that the opponent was launching a campaign that
 "promotes smart tech and O2 Gurus to consumers and businesses". It reports
 that the campaign will run over six weeks "on TV, digital, press and outdoor
 media"⁷;

- An undated e-alert announcing the launch of the opponent's "Guru ad campaign" is shown⁸. Mr Holmes states that it dates from 6 June 2011⁹
- Archived press releases obtained from the opponent's website are provided, one of which relates to its O2 Gurus and is entitled "O2 Gurus to deliver digital bootcamps in South Wales" and dated 29 November 2017 (over 11 months after the relevant date)¹⁰;
- The opponent undertakes numerous marketing campaigns. Marketing
 materials are provided including two flyers, the first promoting the services of
 "our Guru" and the second offering a free appointment with the "O2Guru" at its
 Wisbech outlet. The first has no indication of a date, the second relates to an
 offer that closed in October 2014¹¹;
- Further promotional material relating to "O2Guru" services are provided as an attachment to an internal *PowerPoint* presentation where customers are invited to "Meet the O2 Gurus". They are not dated;
- A news report that appeared on www.thedrum.com, dated 6 October 2014, reported that the opponent was about to launch "the latest phase of its £7m Smart Tech campaign ... with the help of O2 Gurus, who offer free advice instore and online"12:
- The opponent's O2 Gurus were also promoted in e-mail blasts, SIM card
 activation emails and text messages to customers. Undated examples are
 provided. The 2017 end-of-year value statement to customers promoted the
 fact that the opponent had 475 "Gurus on hand to help you at every stage of
 your journey with O2. Speak to an O2 Guru" 13;
- An independent study of the opponent's £479,000 advertising campaign in June and July 2014 in relation to the opponent's O2 Guru brand concluded that there had been an increase from 40,000 to 62,000 hits on the Guru website and reached over 1.5 million consumers in the UK¹⁴;

- Another independent study (undated) found that the opponent's O2 Guru
 YouTube channel was the UK's most popular "How to" channel 15;
- The O2 Guru brand has been popular on social media platforms with more than 9,500 social media mentions of "O2 GURU" across social media platforms between January 2016 and May 2018¹⁶;
- Between 2011 and June 2018 (the date of Mr Holmes' witness statement), the opponent has spent nearly £4.8 million on marketing its Guru brand in the UK¹⁷ and this includes over £1.4 million in 2012, over £2 million in 2013 and nearly £1.3 million in 2014¹⁸
- 44) Most of the evidence referred to above illustrates use of the mark "O2 GURU" either alone or as part of the cloud logo (as shown in the '887 mark). There are numerous references to "GURU" alone by Mr Holmes in his witness statement and in some of the non-customer facing exhibits such as *PowerPoint* presentations reporting the results of independent research, however, there is much less use of GURU alone in the customer-facing material. Where GURU alone is used, it is normally in the context of discussing the opponent's "O2 GURU" service. When taking this into account, together with the other evidence highlighted above, I conclude that the level of inherent distinctive character is not enhanced through such use.
- 45) The use shown in respect of the '887 mark ("O2Guru" and cloud device) is sufficient to illustrate that it does benefit from some enhanced distinctive character. However, because I would not characterise this enhancement as being such as to influence the outcome of my considerations. I find that, even with this enhancement, its level of distinctive character is average.

GLOBAL ASSESSMENT - Conclusions on Likelihood of Confusion

- 46) The following principles are gleaned from the decisions of the CJEU in Sabel BV v Puma AG, Case C-251/95, Canon Kabushiki Kaisha v Metro-Goldwyn-Mayer Inc, Case C-39/97, Lloyd Schuhfabrik Meyer & Co GmbH v Klijsen Handel B.V. Case C-342/97, Marca Mode CV v Adidas AG & Adidas Benelux BV, Case C-425/98, Matratzen Concord GmbH v OHIM, Case C-3/03, Medion AG v. Thomson Multimedia Sales Germany & Austria GmbH, Case C-120/04, Shaker di L. Laudato & C. Sas v OHIM, Case C-334/05P and Bimbo SA v OHIM, Case C-591/12P:
 - (a) The likelihood of confusion must be appreciated globally, taking account of all relevant factors:
 - (b) the matter must be judged through the eyes of the average consumer of the goods or services in question, who is deemed to be reasonably well informed and reasonably circumspect and observant, but who rarely has the chance to make direct comparisons between marks and must instead rely upon the imperfect picture of them he has kept in his mind, and whose attention varies according to the category of goods or services in question;
 - (c) the average consumer normally perceives a mark as a whole and does not proceed to analyse its various details;
 - (d) the visual, aural and conceptual similarities of the marks must normally be assessed by reference to the overall impressions created by the marks bearing in mind their distinctive and dominant components, but it is only when all other components of a complex mark are negligible that it is permissible to make the comparison solely on the basis of the dominant elements;
 - (e) nevertheless, the overall impression conveyed to the public by a composite trade mark may be dominated by one or more of its components;
 - (f) however, it is also possible that in a particular case an element corresponding to an earlier trade mark may retain an independent distinctive

role in a composite mark, without necessarily constituting a dominant element of that mark;

- (g) a lesser degree of similarity between the goods or services may be offset by a great degree of similarity between the marks, and vice versa;
- (h) there is a greater likelihood of confusion where the earlier mark has a highly distinctive character, either per se or because of the use that has been made of it;
- (i) mere association, in the strict sense that the later mark brings the earlier mark to mind, is not sufficient;
- (j) the reputation of a mark does not give grounds for presuming a likelihood of confusion simply because of a likelihood of association in the strict sense;
- (k) if the association between the marks creates a risk that the public might believe that the respective goods or services come from the same or economically-linked undertakings, there is a likelihood of confusion.
- 47) The factors assessed so far have a degree of interdependency (*Canon Kabushiki Kaisha v. Metro-Goldwyn-Mayer Inc*, paragraph 17), a global assessment of them must be made when determining whether there exists a likelihood of confusion (*Sabel BV v. Puma AG*, paragraph 22). These factors must be assessed from the viewpoint of the average consumer. Confusion can be direct (which occurs when the average consumer mistakes one mark for the other) or indirect (where the average consumer realises the marks are not the same, but puts the similarity that exists between the marks/goods/services down to the responsible undertakings being the same or related).

48) I have found that:

The respective services range from being identical to sharing no similarity;

- The holder's mark consists of two words that form a unit;
- The respective marks share a medium level of visual and aural similarity and low or no medium conceptual similarity (where the opponent's mark is perceived as a reference to a spiritual leader) and slightly higher where it is perceived as a reference to a popular expert;
- The average consumer varies between ordinary members of the public whose purchase may be casual and impulsive to commercial clients with an increased level of care and attention being paid during the purchasing process. The purchasing act for all the services is primarily visual in nature, but I keep in mind that aural considerations may play a part;
- The opponent's GURU word mark is endowed with an average (or lower) level
 of inherent distinctive character (where it is perceived as a reference to a
 spiritual leader) and a very low level of distinctive character (where it is
 perceived as a reference to a popular expert) and these levels are not
 enhanced through use.
- 49) The holder's mark forms a unit that will be understood as describing an expert (or guru) in the field of "content" (likely to be understood as a reference to information in an electronic medium such as the Internet). Insofar as it may indicate trade origin, it is the unit created by the combination that does so, with neither word being dominant. With the word GURU being qualified by the word CONTENT, it is unlikely to be perceived as a reference to a spiritual leader. It is likely to be perceived as a reference to a popular expert (in the field of "content"). The consumer is unlikely to attribute any trade significance to the "Guru" element of the mark. When the word GURU is used alone (as in the opponent's mark), it is my view that it is likely to be perceived as a reference to a spiritual leader. Consequently, the coincidence of the *Guru* element in both marks is not likely to lead the consumer to believe there is a trade connection. I find that even where the purchasing act is casual and impulsive and the services are identical, one mark will do no more than bring the other to mind, and there is no likelihood of direct or indirect confusion.
- 50) The other of the earlier marks relied upon may covers some identical services to the holder's designation. However, all of these marks are less similar to the holder's

mark because they contain elements that are absent in the holder's mark. Consequently, any likelihood of confusion is further diminished when compared to the position when the opponent relies upon its GURU word mark. Consequently, none of the opponent's earlier marks place it in a stronger position and I find that there is no likelihood of confusion with any of these earlier marks either. It is my view that this remains the position, even taking into account the enhanced distinctive character of the opponent's '887 mark ("O2Guru" and cloud device). Here the mark is likely to be perceived in one of two ways, either as a popular expert in respect of oxygen (for which "O2" is the chemical symbol) or as the primary mark "O2" plus a secondary mark "Guru". In this latter scenario, because the word elements of the mark do not form a unit, the "Guru" element is likely to retain its meaning of a spiritual leader and have an independent distinctive character. In the former scenario, the word element of the opponent's mark will form a unit that has a different meaning to the holder's mark. In both cases, when taking the opponent's mark as a whole and factoring in the additional elements (that are absent in the holder's mark), I conclude that there is no likelihood of confusion even in circumstances where the respective services are identical.

51) In light of this finding, it is not necessary to consider the holder's submission that its request to add a disclaimer of the word "Guru" in its mark assists its case. However, I comment briefly that as such a disclaimer will not be known to the average consumer and because likelihood of confusion must be considered from the perception of that consumer, the disclaimer would not assist.

52) The opposition, insofar as it is based upon section 5(2)(b) of the Act fails in its entirety.

Section 5(3)

- 53) Section 5(3) states:
 - "(3) A trade mark which
 - (a) is identical with or similar to an earlier trade mark,

(b) (repealed)

shall not be registered if, or to the extent that, the earlier trade mark has a reputation in the United Kingdom (or, in the case of a European Union trade mark or international trade mark (EU) in the European Union) and the use of the later mark without due cause would take unfair advantage of, or be detrimental to, the distinctive character or the repute of the earlier trade mark."

- 54) The relevant case law can be found in the following judgments of the CJEU: Case C-375/97, *General Motors*, [1999] ETMR 950, Case 252/07, *Intel*, [2009] ETMR 13, Case C-408/01, *Adidas-Salomon*, [2004] ETMR 10 and C-487/07, *L'Oreal v Bellure* [2009] ETMR 55 and Case C-323/09, *Marks and Spencer v Interflora*. The law appears to be as follows.
 - a) The reputation of a trade mark must be established in relation to the relevant section of the public as regards the goods or services for which the mark is registered; *General Motors, paragraph 24.*
 - (b) The trade mark for which protection is sought must be known by a significant part of that relevant public; General Motors, paragraph 26.
 - (c) It is necessary for the public when confronted with the later mark to make a link with the earlier reputed mark, which is the case where the public calls the earlier mark to mind; *Adidas Saloman, paragraph 29* and *Intel, paragraph 63*
 - (d) Whether such a link exists must be assessed globally taking account of all relevant factors, including the degree of similarity between the respective marks and between the goods/services, the extent of the overlap between the relevant consumers for those goods/services, and the strength of the earlier mark's reputation and distinctiveness; *Intel, paragraph 42*
 - (e) Where a link is established, the owner of the earlier mark must also establish the existence of one or more of the types of injury set out in the

section, or there is a serious likelihood that such an injury will occur in the future; *Intel, paragraph 68;* whether this is the case must also be assessed globally, taking account of all relevant factors; *Intel, paragraph 79.*

- (f) Detriment to the distinctive character of the earlier mark occurs when the mark's ability to identify the goods/services for which it is registered is weakened as a result of the use of the later mark, and requires evidence of a change in the economic behaviour of the average consumer of the goods/services for which the earlier mark is registered, or a serious risk that this will happen in future; *Intel, paragraphs 76 and 77.*
- (g) The more unique the earlier mark appears, the greater the likelihood that the use of a later identical or similar mark will be detrimental to its distinctive character; *Intel, paragraph 74.*
- (h) Detriment to the reputation of the earlier mark is caused when goods or services for which the later mark is used may be perceived by the public in such a way that the power of attraction of the earlier mark is reduced, and occurs particularly where the goods or services offered under the later mark have a characteristic or quality which is liable to have a negative impact of the earlier mark; *L'Oreal v Bellure NV*, paragraph 40.
- (i) The advantage arising from the use by a third party of a sign similar to a mark with a reputation is an unfair advantage where it seeks to ride on the coat-tails of the senior mark in order to benefit from the power of attraction, the reputation and the prestige of that mark and to exploit, without paying any financial compensation, the marketing effort expended by the proprietor of the mark in order to create and maintain the mark's image. This covers, in particular, cases where, by reason of a transfer of the image of the mark or of the characteristics which it projects to the goods identified by the identical or similar sign, there is clear exploitation on the coat-tails of the mark with a reputation (*Marks and Spencer v Interflora, paragraph 74 and the court's answer to question 1 in L'Oreal v Bellure*).

Reputation

55) In Iron & Smith kft v Unilever NV, Case C-125/14, the CJEU held that:

"If the earlier Community trade mark has already acquired a reputation in a substantial part of the territory of the European Union, but not with the relevant public in the Member State in which registration of the later national mark concerned by the opposition has been applied for, the proprietor of the Community trade mark may benefit from the protection introduced by Article 4(3) of Directive 2008/95 where it is shown that a commercially significant part of that public is familiar with that mark, makes a connection between it and the later national mark, and that there is, taking account of all the relevant factors in the case, either actual and present injury to its mark, for the purposes of that provision or, failing that, a serious risk that such injury may occur in the future."

56) That case deals with a situation where, in the relevant member state, there was no reputation of the EU mark. In the current case, I have found use sufficient to result in an enhanced level of distinctive character of the opponent's O2Guru (and cloud device). I find that such use is sufficient to demonstrate the requisite reputation in respect of *information and advisory services relating to the aforesaid* [that includes *Cellular telephone communication*] upon which to base the opposition upon section 5(3). I found no enhanced distinctive character in respect of the earlier mark GURU/ Guru. I also find that the evidence is insufficient to find that this mark has the requisite reputation for the purposes of section 5(3). Therefore, I go on to consider the existence of a link based only on the opponent's mark O2Guru (and cloud device). No other of its earlier marks improve its position.

Link

57) When assessing the existence of a link, I keep in mind the following guidance of the CJEU in Case C-408/01, *Adidas-Salomon*:

- "28. The condition of similarity between the mark and the sign, referred to in Article 5(2) of the Directive, requires the existence, in particular, of elements of visual, aural or conceptual similarity (see, in respect of Article 5(1)(b) of the Directive, Case C-251/95 SABEL [1997] ECR I-6191, paragraph 23 in fine, and Case C-342/97 Lloyd Schuhfabrik Meyer [1999] ECR I-3819, paragraphs 25 and 27 in fine).
- 29. The infringements referred to in Article 5(2) of the Directive, where they occur, are the consequence of a certain degree of similarity between the mark and the sign, by virtue of which the relevant section of the public makes a connection between the sign and the mark, that is to say, establishes a link between them even though it does not confuse them (see, to that effect, Case C-375/97 *General Motors* [1999] ECR I-5421, paragraph 23)."
- 58) Therefore, the assessment of similarity between the respective marks is the same as for section 5(2). However, I also keep in mind that the level of similarity required for the public to make a link between the marks for the purposes of 5(3) may be less than the level of similarity required to create a likelihood of confusion (*Intra-Presse SAS v OHIM*, Joined cases C-581/13P & C-582/13P, paragraph 72).
- 59) As I commented earlier, the opponent's '887 mark is likely to be perceived in one of two ways, either forming a unit to function as a reference to a popular expert in respect of oxygen or as two individual elements retaining their own distinctive character and function as the primary mark "O2" plus a secondary mark "Guru". I concluded that because of this, and when factoring the additional elements present in the opponent's mark, there is no likelihood of confusion even in circumstances where the respective services are identical.
- 60) Taking all of the above into account, I accept that, as a result of the common occurrence of the word "Guru" in both marks, the holder's mark may bring the opponent's mark to mind in circumstances where the respective services are identical. However, whilst this is sufficient to establish the requisite link, I find that the link is likely to be so fleeting and weak that it is very unlikely that use of the holder's mark will result in any detriment or unfair advantage.

61) I conclude that the opposition, insofar as it is based upon section 5(3) of the Act, fails.

Summary

62) The opposition fails on all grounds and the UK designation of the IR can proceed.

Costs

63) The holder has been successful and is entitled to a contribution towards his costs. Awards of costs are governed by Annex A of Tribunal Practice Notice (TPN) 2 of 2016. I take account that only the opponent filed evidence but that the holder filed written observations in reply. I award costs as follows:

Considering evidence £500

Preparation of written observations £350

TOTAL £1200

64) I order O2 Worldwide Limited to pay to Mezrin Lurii Valeriiovych the sum of £1200. This sum is to be paid within fourteen days of the expiry of the appeal period or within fourteen days of the final determination of this case if any appeal against this decision is unsuccessful.
