1. It has been brought to my attention that my decision O/1118/22 contained an administrative error at paragraph 47, which read as follows:

“47. The opposition succeeds in full. The application will, therefore, be refused for all the goods and services for which registration is sought.”

2. To reflect the correct findings of the conclusion of the decision, the paragraph below should read in place of the original paragraph above:

“47. The opposition succeeds in full. The application will, therefore, be refused for the goods and services opposed but proceed to registration for those goods unopposed. “

3. This error is plainly an irregularity in procedure and capable of being corrected under Rule 74 of the Trade Marks Rules 2008. Consequently, I give the parties notice that paragraph 47 of the decision will be amended as stated above and apply as though it had appeared in the original version of the decision.

4. The appeal period in respect of opposition 430572 begins from the date of this supplementary decision.
