This is an appeal from a determination of the Professional Conduct Committee of the General Medical Council dated 11th March 1985. By that determination the Committee, having at an earlier sitting found the appellant guilty of serious professional misconduct, directed that his registration should be suspended for 6 months. The appellant seeks to reverse that finding and also maintains that the sentence was in any event excessive.

Mr. Davies, for the appellant, has said exceedingly well all that could possibly be said on Dr. Addy's behalf. Their Lordships are however unable to find any grounds for disturbing the finding of the Professional Conduct Committee or any room for the view that the sentence imposed on Dr. Addy ought to be set aside.

Their Lordships will humbly advise Her Majesty that this appeal should be dismissed. The appellant must pay the respondent's costs.
