And whereas by virtue of the Agriculture Act, 1947 (Commencement) Order, 1947,(a) the Agriculture Act, 1947 (Commencement) (No. 1) Order, 1948,(b) and the Agriculture Act, 1947 (Commencement) (No. 2) Order, 1948,(c) the provisions of the said Act specified in the said Orders came into operation on the respective dates thereby appointed:

And whereas it is expedient that the further provisions of the said Act hereinafter specified should come into operation on the date hereinafter appointed:

Now, therefore, His Majesty is pleased by and with the advice of His Privy Council to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

- 1. Sections 98 to 100 of the said Act and section 110 thereof (so far as it relates to the enactments set out in the Schedule to this Order) shall come into operation on the 1st day of June, 1948.
- 2. This Order may be cited as the Agriculture Act, 1947 (Commencement) (No. 3) Order, 1948.
