**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A120 Trunk Road (Harwich Road, Near Wix, Essex)  
(Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010**

<i>Made</i> - - - -	<i>25 October 2010</i>
<i>Coming into force</i> - -	<i>1 November 2010</i>

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A120 Trunk Road (“the A120”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road in the County of Essex should be restricted and prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A120 Trunk Road (Harwich Road, Near Wix, Essex) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 1 November 2010.

2. In this Order –

“the first length of trunk road” means the A120 Harwich Road –

- (a) eastbound carriageway between points 1.30 kilometres west, and 300 metres west, of the centre line of its junction with Primrose Lane, and
- (b) westbound carriageway between points 1.10 kilometres east, and 100 metres east, of the centre line of its junction with the Access Road (west of Primrose Lane);

“the second length of trunk road” means the A120 from a point 300 metres west of the centre line of its junction with the Access Road (west of Primrose Lane) to a point 100 metres east of Primrose Lane;

“works” mean resurfacing works to the trunk road;

“a works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 8 November 2010 or on any subsequent day until the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 5 no person shall, during a works period, drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding –

- (a) 40 miles per hour on the first length of trunk road, or

(b) 10 miles per hour on a length of the second length of trunk road whilst traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Traffic Road Regulation Act 1984 indicating “convoy working” on that length are displayed.

4. Subject as mentioned in article 5 no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to overtake any other moving vehicle on the first length of trunk road or the second length of trunk road.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to a vehicle -

- (a) being used for, or in connection with, the said works, or for winter service maintenance or traffic officer purposes,
- (b) being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes, or
- (c) proceeding at the direction, or with the permission of, a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
