ROAD TRAFFIC

The A120 Trunk Road (Harwich Road, Near Wix, Essex) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010

Made - - - - 25 October 2010

Coming into force - - 1 November 2010

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A120 Trunk Road ("the A120"), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road in the County of Essex should be restricted and prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A120 Trunk Road (Harwich Road, Near Wix, Essex) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 1 November 2010.

2. In this Order –

"the first length of trunk road" means the A120 Harwich Road –

- (a) eastbound carriageway between points 1.30 kilometres west, and 300 metres west, of the centre line of its junction with Primrose Lane, and
- (b) westbound carriageway between points 1.10 kilometres east, and 100 metres east, of the centre line of its junction with the Access Road (west of Primrose Lane);

"the second length of trunk road" means the A120 from a point 300 metres west of the centre line of its junction with the Access Road (west of Primrose Lane) to a point 100 metres east of Primrose Lane;

"works" mean resurfacing works to the trunk road;

"a works period" means a period of 10 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 8 November 2010 or on any subsequent day until the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 5 no person shall, during a works period, drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding
 - (a) 40 miles per hour on the first length of trunk road, or

- (b) 10 miles per hour on a length of the second length of trunk road whilst traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Traffic Road Regulation Act 1984 indicating "convoy working" on that length are displayed.
- **4.** Subject as mentioned in article 5 no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to overtake any other moving vehicle on the first length of trunk road or the second length of trunk road.
- **5.** The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to a vehicle -
 - (a) being used for, or in connection with, the said works, or for winter service maintenance or traffic officer purposes,
 - (b) being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes, or
 - (c) proceeding at the direction, or with the permission of, a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
