ROAD TRAFFIC

**The M1 Motorway (Junction 14, Milton Keynes) Southbound
Entry Slip Road (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011**

Made - - - - - *31st May 2011*
Coming into force - - - - - *7th June 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M1 Motorway (“the M1”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those connecting roads in the Borough of Milton Keynes should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M1 Motorway (Junction 14, Milton Keynes) Southbound Entry Slip Road (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 7th June 2011.

2. Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order no person shall, during a period of 8 hours starting at 21:00 hours on Monday 13th June 2011, or on any subsequent day until resurfacing and road marking works have been completed, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the southbound entry slip road leading from the M1/A509 Interchange at Junction 14.

3. The provisions of article 2 above shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the works.
