ROAD TRAFFIC

The A259 Trunk Road (Pevensey Levels) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A259 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on a length of that road because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act $1984(\mathbf{a})$, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A259 Trunk Road (Pevensey Levels) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 3rd September 2011.

2. In this Order:

"the trunk road" means the A259 Trunk Road near Pevensey in the County of East Sussex;

"the length of trunk road" means both carriageways of the trunk road from the roundabout at its junction with the A27 at Pevensey to a point 800 metres southwest of Middle Bridge;

"works" mean resurfacing and all associated work on the trunk road; and

"a works period" means a period of 9½ hours starting at 1930 hours on Monday 5th September 2011 or on any subsequent day until 2nd March 2013.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the length of trunk road.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, traffic officer or fire and rescue authority purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes; or
- (e) a vehicle proceeding in the length of trunk road to or from premises accessible from, and only from, that road, to such extent as shall be indicated by traffic signs.
