ROAD TRAFFIC

The M3 Motorway (Junction 5, Eastbound Entry Slip Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M3 Motorway and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on one of those connecting roads because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act $1984(\mathbf{a})$, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M3 Motorway (Junction 5, Eastbound Entry Slip Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 24th September 2011.

2. In this Order:

"the motorway" means the M3 Motorway east of Basingstoke in the County of Hampshire;

"the slip road" means the road leading to the eastbound carriageway of the motorway from the A287/B3349 at Junction 5 at Hook Interchange;

"works" mean carriageway repairs and all associated work on the motorway; and

"a works period" means a period of –

- (i) 8 hours starting at 2200 hours on Monday 26th September 2011 or on any subsequent day other than a Saturday or Sunday, or
- (ii) 9 hours starting at 2100 hours on Saturday 2nd October 2011 or on any subsequent Saturday,

until 23rd March 2013.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, traffic officer or fire and rescue authority purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
