ROAD TRAFFIC

The A5 Trunk Road (Churncote Roundabout to Bayleys Roundabout, Shrewsbury) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

Made - - - - 24th January 2011

Coming into force - - 31st January 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A5 Trunk Road ("the A5"), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road at Shrewsbury in the County of Shropshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A5 Trunk Road (Churncote Roundabout to Bayleys Roundabout, Shrewsbury) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 31st January 2011.

2. In this Order:

"the trunk road" means the eastbound and westbound carriageways of the

A5 from its roundabout junction with the A458 (Churncote Roundabout) to its roundabout junction with the A49/A5112 near Bayston Hill (known as Bayleys

Roundabout);

"the works period" means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 7

February 2011 and ending when the said works have been

completed,

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road.

- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
 - **5.** The provisions of article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle-
 - (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes,
 - (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable, or
 - (iii) being used in connection with the said works.
