ROAD TRAFFIC

**The M6 Motorway (Junction 4) and the A446 Trunk Road
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011**

Made - - - - - *31st October 2011*
Coming into force - - - *7th November 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M6 Motorway (“the M6”), the A446 Trunk Road (“the A446”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on lengths of the A446 and on two of those connecting roads, south of Coleshill in the County of Warwickshire and in the Metropolitan Borough of Solihull, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as The M6 Motorway (Junction 4) and the A446 Trunk Road (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 7th November 2011.

2. In this Order:

“the roundabout” means the circulatory carriageway of the A446 at its roundabout junction with the M6 (Junction 4);

“the trunk road” means –

- i) the northbound carriageway of the A446 from its junction with the A452/Chester Road to its roundabout junction with the M6 at Junction 4; and
- ii) the southbound carriageway of the A446 from its roundabout junction with Coleshill Heath Road to its junction with the M6 at Junction 4;

“the link road” means the link road leading to the northbound carriageway of the A446 from its roundabout junction with the A452/Chester Road/Bickenhill Parkway;

(a) 1984 c.27; a new section 14 was substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 (c.26), section 1(1) and Schedule 1

“the slip road” means the slip road leading from the A446 to the northbound carriageway of the M6 at Junction 4;

“the works period” means the period starting at 22:00 hours on Monday 14th November 2011 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the roundabout, the trunk road, the link road or the slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle -

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable, or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (c) being used for or in connection with the said works or by a traffic officer in uniform.
