ROAD TRAFFIC

**The M61 Motorway (Junction 6, Northbound Exit Slip Road)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011**

Made - - - - - *16th February 2011*

Coming into force - - - - - *6th March 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M61 Motorway and slip roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those slip roads in the District of Bolton in Greater Manchester should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as the M61 Motorway (Junction 6, Northbound Exit Slip Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 6th March 2011.

2. In this Order:

“the slip road” means the exit slip road leading from the northbound carriageway of the M61 Motorway at Junction 6;

“the works period” means periods overnight between 2200 hours and 0500 hours (continuing to 0700 hours on Saturdays and Sundays) starting on Monday 7 March 2011 and ending on Monday 28 March 2011. However, work may start and continue between the same times on subsequent nights or continue overnight until completed, for such period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work;

“Works” means barrier installation and traffic sign replacement works on the slip road.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works or by traffic officers, or for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue or ambulance services, or proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
