ROAD TRAFFIC

The A46 Trunk Road (Binley, Coventry) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012

Made 4th April 2012 Coming into force - - -11th April 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A46 Trunk Road ("the A46"), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road at Binley, near Coventry, should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A46 Trunk Road (Binley, Coventry) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 11th April 2012.

2. In this Order –

"the Roundabout" means the circulatory carriageway of the A46 at its

roundabout junction with the A428 at Binley;

"the first length of trunk road" means the northbound carriageway of the A46

from a point 1.6 km south of the Roundabout to that

roundabout;

"the second length of trunk road" means the southbound carriageway of the A46

from a point 1.6 km north of the Roundabout to that

roundabout;

"the works period" means the period starting on Wednesday 18th April 2012

and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the first length of trunk road or the second length of trunk road.

- **4.** Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the Roundabout.
- **5**. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
 - **6**. The provisions of:
 - (a) article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle being used for special forces purposes;
 - (b) articles 3 and 4 shall not apply to any vehicle
 - (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or
 - (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; and
 - (c) article 4, shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works.
