ROAD TRAFFIC

The A1(M) Motorway (Junction 42, Selby Fork) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012

 Made
 5th July 2012

 Coming into force
 15th July 2012

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A1(M) Motorway, the A63 Trunk Road and connecting roads, in the District of Selby, in the County of North Yorkshire, is satisfied that traffic on some of those connecting roads should be prohibited because carriageway resurfacing and general maintenance works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order: -

- **1.** This Order may be cited as the A1(M) Motorway (Junction 42, Selby Fork) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 15th July 2012.
- **2.** Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order, no person shall, during a period of 11 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 16th July 2012 or any subsequent night thereafter until the said works have been completed, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the:
 - (i) A1(M) Motorway northbound or southbound entry or exit slip roads at Junction 42 (Selby Fork);
 - (ii) A63 Trunk Road between the eastern and western roundabouts at Junction 42, a distance of 165 metres; or
 - (iii) A63 Trunk Road eastern roundabout or western roundabout at Junction 42.
- **3.** The provisions of article 2 of this order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:
 - (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
 - (b) a vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the said works, or for winter maintenance or traffic officer purposes; or
 - (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform.
