ROAD TRAFFIC

The A45 Trunk Road (Brackmills to Earls Barton, Northampton) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012

Made---8th October 2012Coming into force--15th October 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A45 Trunk Road ("the A45") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on four of those connecting roads, near Northampton in the County of Northamptonshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A45 Trunk Road (Brackmills to Earls Barton, Northampton) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 15th October 2012.

2. In this Order:

"a slip road"

means the slip road leading -

- i) from the northbound carriageway of the A45 to its roundabout junction with the A5076 (Billing Interchange);
- ii) to the southbound carriageway of the A45 from its roundabout junction with the A5076 (Billing Interchange);
- iii) to the northbound carriageway of the A45 from its roundabout junction with the A428 and A5095 (Barnes Meadow Interchange); and
- iv) from the southbound carriageway of the A45 to its roundabout junction with the A428 and A5095 (Barnes Meadow Interchange).

"the works period"

means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 22nd October 2012 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in a slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle-

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- (c) being used in connection with the said works.
