ROAD TRAFFIC

The A5103 Trunk Road (Southbound Exit Slip Road to the A560 and the Northbound Entry Slip Road from the B5167) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012

Made - - - - 31st January 2012

Coming into force - - 5th February 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A5103 Trunk Road and its slip roads, is satisfied that traffic on two of those slip roads in the District of Manchester in Greater Manchester should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A5103 Trunk Road (Southbound Exit Slip Road to the A560 and the Northbound Entry Slip Road from the B5167) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 5th February 2012.

2. In this Order;

"trunk road" means the A5103 Trunk Road;

"works" means the resurfacing, loop cutting, road marking and maintenance works;

"the works period" means four nights between 2200 hours and 0500 hours during a period starting on Monday 6 February 2012 and ending on Tuesday 21 February 2012. However, work may start and continue between the same times on subsequent nights or continue until completed, for such period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work;

"the first slip road" means the exit slip road leading from the southbound carriageway of the trunk road to the A560 (Altrincham Road);

"the second slip road" means the entry slip road leading to the northbound carriageway of the trunk road from the B5167 (Wythenshawe Road);

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the first and second slip roads.

4.	The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only at such times and to such extent
	as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle
	being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue or ambulance services,
	vehicles being used in connection with the works, or by traffic officers, or to any vehicle
	proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in
	uniform.
