ROAD TRAFFIC

The M602 Motorway (Junction 2 Westbound Entry Slip Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012

Made - - - - 8th February 2012 Coming into force - - 12th February 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M602 Motorway and slip roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those slip roads in the District of Salford in Greater Manchester should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M602 Motorway (Junction 2 Westbound Entry Slip Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 12th February 2012.

2. In this Order;

"motorway" means the M602 Motorway;

"works" means resurfacing works on the slip road;

"the works period" means five nights between 2200 hours and 0500 hours starting on Monday 13 February 2012 and ending on Saturday 18 February 2012. However, work may start and continue between the same times on subsequent nights or continue overnight until completed, for such period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work;

"the slip road" means the entry slip road leading to the westbound carriageway of the motorway at Junction 2.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip road.

4.	The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only at such times and to such extent
	as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle
	being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue or ambulance services,
	vehicles being used in connection with the works, or by traffic officers, or to any vehicle
	proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in
	uniform.
