ROAD TRAFFIC

The M5 Motorway (Junction 5) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012

 Made
 2nd March 2012

 Coming into force
 9th March 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M5 Motorway ("the M5") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on some of those connecting roads near Wychbold in the County of Worcestershire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as The M5 Motorway (Junction 5) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 9th March 2012.

2. In this Order:

"the roundabout" means the circulatory carriageway of the northern

roundabout at M5 Junction 5;

"the slip road" means the slip road leading from the southbound

carriageway of the M5 at Junction 5;

"the link road" means the link road leading from its roundabout junction

with the A38 and the slip roads leading to and from the northbound carriageway of the M5 at Junction 5, to the

roundabout;

"the works period" means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Tuesday 13th

March 2012 and ending when the said works have been

completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the roundabout, the slip road or the link road.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle -
 - (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
 - (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable, or traffic officer in uniform; or
 - (c) being used for or in connection with the said works or by a traffic officer in uniform.
