The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Bournemouth) Regulations 2012

The Secretary of State deems it necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the vicinity of Bournemouth, Dorset by reason of the holding of flying displays that are scheduled to take place during the period from 30th August to 2nd September 2012.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 161 of the Air Navigation Order $2009(\mathbf{a})$.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Bournemouth) Regulations 2012 and come into force on 30th August 2012.

2. In regulation 3 all times referred to are Co-ordinated Universal Time.

3.—(1) Subject to paragraph (2)—

- (a) between 1200 hours and 2000 hours on 30th and 31st August 2012, and
- (b) between 1100 hours and 1700 hours on 1st and 2nd September 2012,

no aircraft is to fly below 5,500 feet above mean sea level within the area bounded by straight lines joining successively the following points—

504304N 0015636W, 504405N 0014703W, 504016N 0014604W, 503914N 0015537W, and 504304N 0015636W.

(2) Paragraph (1) does not apply to any aircraft flying-

- (a) in accordance with a clearance issued by the air traffic control unit at either Bournemouth Airport or Southampton Airport; or
- (b) with the permission of the flying display director for the Bournemouth Air Festival.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations impose restrictions on flying in airspace in the vicinity of the seafront at Bournemouth, Dorset during the Bournemouth Air Festival which will take place between 30th August and 2nd September 2012. A large number of aircraft will be involved in high-energy manoeuvres during the Air Festival. The Civil Aviation Authority's Safety Regulation Group and Directorate of Airspace Policy, with the agreement of the Department for Transport, consider that flying should be restricted during the air show in the vicinity of Bournemouth for reasons of public safety.

In relation to the permission mentioned in regulation 3(2)(b), the Bournemouth Air Festival flying display director may be contacted on telephone 07979 593941.

Full details of the airspace restrictions will be promulgated by Aeronautical Information Circular and NOTAM.
