**The A590 Trunk Road (Newby Bridge)
(40 Miles Per Hour Speed Limit) Order 2013**

14 March 2013

Coming into force

28 March 2013

The Secretary of State for Transport in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 84(1)(a) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order on the A590 Trunk Road in the District of South Lakeland in the County of Cumbria:

1. This Order may be cited as The A590 Trunk Road (Newby Bridge) (40 Miles Per Hour Speed Limit) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 28 March 2013.
2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A590 Trunk Road from a point 60 metres south east of the point at which the A590 Trunk Road meets the A590/A592 circulatory carriageway at its north west entry point, to a point 125 metres east of the eastern bull nose of the kerbed island of the dual carriageway section of the A590 Trunk Road, immediately west of Newby Bridge;
3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, no person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour in the trunk road;
4. Nothing in article 3 of this Order shall apply to any vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue or ambulance services.
